Dear Mr. Cooper (Chairman) and Members of the Board of Directors

Thank you for your kind invitation to the joint meeting of UNIBOA National Board of Directors and the National Administration (officers) schedule for February 11 at 10:00am. The National Administration believes that the meeting is in the right direction. We believe that unity is our strength and matters effecting the organization must be handled in a family way. Unfortunately, the administration will not participate in the February 11, 2023 mediation meeting due to an ongoing investigation or matter that concern you (Mr. Glenn Cooper). The matter being investigated is fraudulent and it does appear that violations of UNIBOA's constitution took place.

The administration takes such allegations seriously and is requesting the opening of a full investigation of Mr. Glenn Cooper of what appears to be illegally attempting to freeze UNIBOA's account and fraudulently attempting to gain access to UNIBOA's account (to be added as a signer) without any constitutional authority.

Mr. Chairman, the administration did notify you immediately on February 3rd 2023 upon receiving these reports from Bank of America to confirm with you that indeed you were not involved with these transactions. Unfortunately, the administration has not heard back from you or has received any response or cooperation from you.

Please be reminded Mr. Chairman that we took an oath to uphold, protect, and defend UNIBOA's constitution and that includes protecting the organization resources and finances. Due to the rapid speed of development of this matter, and the potential of the criminal nature of these actions, we have no alternative but to let the law take its course for potential fraud investigation.

I look forward to a prompt respond to this request.
